12:30pm Kick Off

Thank you for booking matchday hospitality in the Presidents Suite. Please find below your matchday itinerary:-

Prior to your arrival on matchday please ensure all attendees read and abide by the Supporters' Code of Conduct which has been introduced to help reduce the spread of COVID-19. A link to this can be found at www.leedsunited.com/club/codeofconduct. This includes the necessary information on the mandatory entry requirements for all fixtures.

For all guests with a seasonal car parking bay in the John Charles West Stand Car Park please ensure that you have parked your vehicle by 11:00am which will enable you direct access to the West Stand Reception without delay. Should you arrive later than 11:00am entry will not be permitted into the John Charles Car Park and you will be required to park in an alternative car park.

All hospitality guests (except those with a seasonal John Charles West Stand Car Park pass) are required to arrive at the Fullerton Car Park for entry to the West Stand hospitality suites. Guests will be directed to the West Stand Reception and Presidents Suite from the Fullerton Car Park.

Please note that car parking in the Fullerton Car Park is only available to seasonal pass holders. Should you require car parking, the Park and Ride area (accessible via Bobby Collins Way) and Car Park B (opposite the Club Shop) provide spaces, payable on the day. Please see the Elland Road stadium plan on your hospitality ticket wallet for reference.

If you have arranged to collect your matchday hospitality tickets on arrival, please go straight to the West Stand Hospitality Desk which is located at the West Stand Reception.

9:30am-10:15am Arrive at the West Stand Reception where you will be welcomed by our matchday reception staff.

All bags will be checked prior to entering the stadium. Please avoid bringing any large bags as any items bigger than A4 size will not be permitted into the stadium. We are unable to store any items for guests.

Your matchday hospitality ticket or seasonal hospitality access card will be scanned and a matchday lanyard will be issued which you must wear and keep visible at all times whilst at Elland Road.

Our matchday hostesses will greet you and direct you to your reserved table in the Presidents Suite.

10:15am As a guest of the Presidents Suite, you will enjoy a first-class pre-match hospitality experience, starting with a glass of champagne of arrival.

Your pre-match three course meal and complimentary drinks will be served direct to your table in the Presidents Suite via your dedicated waiter or waitress.

A complimentary copy of the matchday programme and teamsheet for each guest will be delivered to your table.

Please allow adequate time to enjoy your hospitality. Should you arrive after 10:30am we can not guarantee the pre-match meal will be served prior to kick off.





- 12:15pm** Take your executive match seats in the West Stand.
- 12:30pm** Kick off.
- 1:15pm** Half time. Return to the Presidents Suite where refreshments will be available.
- 1:25pm** Make your way back to your executive match seats for the second half.
- 2:15pm** Full time. Return to the Presidents Suite, where refreshments will be served and bar service to your table will remain available for one hour after the final whistle. You will also be able to watch the post-match Man of the Match interview on the TV screens.

Directly after full time the away control zone will be in operation and all away fans will be cleared from the stadium immediately. Although this is not compulsory, we strongly recommend that all guests return to the Presidents Suite, allow the crowds and traffic to clear and depart the stadium at 2:45pm or wait a minimum of 15 minutes after full time.

The above times are for guidance only and are subject to change on the day

Your hospitality suite and match seats are located in a Leeds home area. Whilst we do welcome visiting supporters, please ensure guests refrain from wearing away club colours including scarves and are not seen openly supporting the away team as you may be refused entry to the stadium or ejected without compensation. Visiting supporters are therefore advised to act discreetly.

Elland Road is moving to become a cashless venue this season and we request that all payments for drinks outside of your inclusive package be made by using card payment. We hope that this will deliver an increased speed in service with less wait time as well as help reduce the spread of COVID-19.

The dress code in the Presidents' Suite is strictly jacket, trousers, collar and tie. Under no circumstances can trainers, jeans, football shirts or other sports apparel be worn on matchday. Please ensure you adhere to the dress code as failure to do so will result in non admittance to the area. Children under the age of 16 need not adhere to the dress code.

We look forward to welcoming you and your guests to Elland Road, the home of Leeds United.
