

To assist you in planning your journey, the following information may be of use:

**BY ROAD:**

**FROM THE NORTH**

A1, M1, A639 to Leeds. Join M621 to Junction 1. Take A6110 from Roundabout into Elland Road.

**FROM THE SOUTH**

M1, M621 to Junction 1. Take A6110 from Roundabout into Elland Road.

**FROM THE EAST**

A64, A1, then as from North or M62, M621 to Junction 1. Take A6110 from roundabout into Elland Road.

**FROM THE WEST**

M62, M621, to Junction 1. Take A6110 from roundabout into Elland Road.

**PARKING:**

There are a number of Leeds City Council controlled car parks situated around the stadium. The current charges for parking are; cars £6, mini coaches £12, coaches £20. Street parking is restricted due to resident permits. Disabled parking is available for use by Blue Badge Holders. The car parks are managed by the Parks & Countryside service of Leeds City Council, and can be contacted by telephone on **0113 395**

**BY RAIL**

Leeds Railway Station is 2 miles away. London trains depart/arrive from Kings Cross. Journey time approximately 2 hours 30 minutes. Regular services available.

**BUS:**

Bus numbers 51 / 52 / 55 also travel from Leeds City Centre along Elland Road and stop outside of the stadium. Along Elland Road, please note that bus stops outside the ground are suspended one hour before and one hour after a home match.

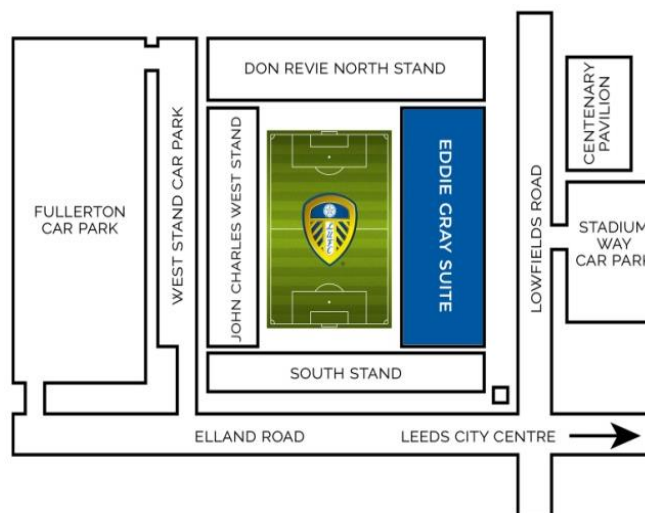
**\*SUBJECT TO LICENCE**

**Shuttle Bus**

Available from midday (2 hours before gates open) from Sovereign Street. The Shuttle Bus will cost £3 for a return and will be running for 1 hour after the event finishes.

**Taxi**

There are designated Uber pick up zones outside the East Stand for guests wishing to travel to the event by taxi.



### **Ticket Sales & Ticket Collections:**

The ticket box office is located on Elland Road on the west side of the stadium. The office is open from 1pm – 9:30pm.

### **REFRESHMENTS:**

A range of catering facilities offering a variety of food and drink will be available within the Stadium. Catering facilities take both cash and card, however hospitality bars may only accept cash.

### **NO CAMERAS OR TAPE RECORDERS:**

Please do not bring any kind of recording equipment as this will not be permitted within the Stadium. There is no facility for storing confiscated equipment. Entry to the event may be refused.

### **FIRST AID:**

First Aid points will be clearly signed throughout the Stadium.

### **PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING ADVICE FROM WEST YORKSHIRE POLICE REGARDING YOUR JOURNEY:**

West Yorkshire Police would like you to enjoy your visit to Elland Road and would therefore recommend that you plan your journey to arrive in plenty of time to park and make your way to the Stadium. With approx 20,000 attending, the concert expected to be really popular, the motorways and the roads in the vicinity of the Stadium will be very congested.

Please park responsibly, vehicles causing an unlawful obstruction may be removed at the owner's expense.

In relation to crime prevention, please ensure you keep your personal belongings secure and out of sight.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

We look forward to welcoming you to Elland Road. We ask for your cooperation and request you abide by the following guidelines designed to assist you:

### **DO's:**

#### **Keep your ticket with you at all times**

Allow ample time for your journey, parking and admission early enough to see the start of the concert.

Bring weatherproof / appropriate clothing.

Put any rubbish in the bins provided.

Look for official vendors and concession stalls, avoid unlicensed traders outside of the ground offering inferior goods.

Be respectful of our local residents when leaving the Stadium late evening.

### **DON'T's:**

Please DO NOT bring a bag where possible. No backpacks or bags over A4 size will be permitted.

Bring food or drink into the Stadium (unless it is for medicinal purposes).

Bring aerosol cans, glass or flasks.

Bring pushchairs, picnics or camping equipment.

### **Corporate Guest Access**

Corporate guests are advised to arrive around XX and report to the East Stand Reception. Guests will then be directed to their suite / box ahead of the centenary event commencing.

### **ACCESS:**

Gates will open at 2pm, with the first act due to start around 3pm. Disabled guests have 2 entry points: L28 area via the reception on the east side of the stadium, and via gates 2 & 3 located in the north east corner to access the viewing platform. Disabled access customers will receive an email letting them know which entry to use. Upon entry, access customers will make themselves known to the door staff / stewards and receive a paper access wristband before being escorted to their designated area.

Due to Counter Terrorism measures, all bags and personal belongings will be searched on entry and we ask for your understanding and patience in this regard

### **SEATING/STANDING:**

Seats for this performance may be covered or uncovered. The concert will not be cancelled in the event of inclement weather.

Please bring clothing appropriate to the expected weather conditions.

Umbrellas will not be allowed within the Stadium. Please note that we do not have a left luggage facility.

### **Last Entry:**

Last entry is 9:30pm, anyone arriving after this point will be denied entry. There will be no readmissions, please plan ahead
